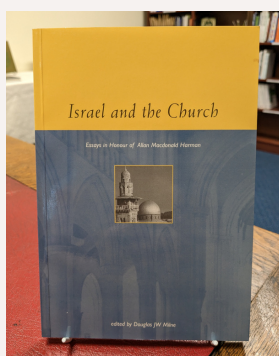


REACHING FORWARD

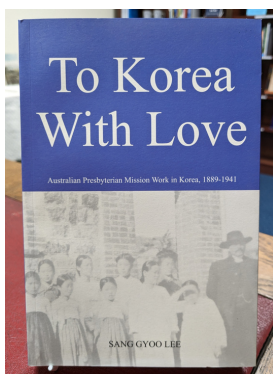

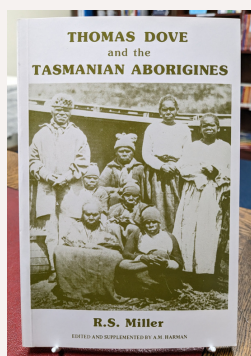

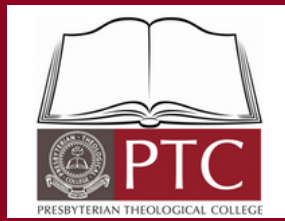


THOMAS DOVE AND THE TASMANIAN ABORIGINES

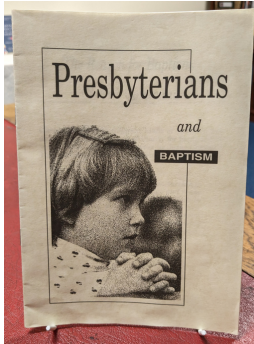

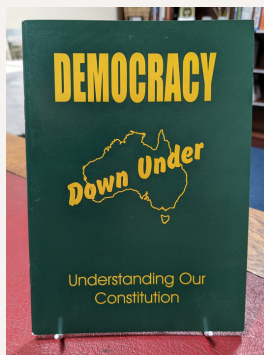


LEARNING THE CHRISTIAN FAITH

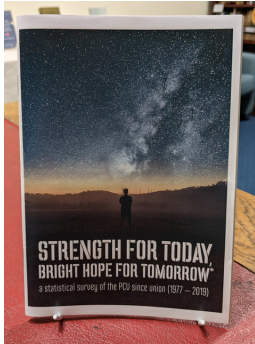
Mairi Harman

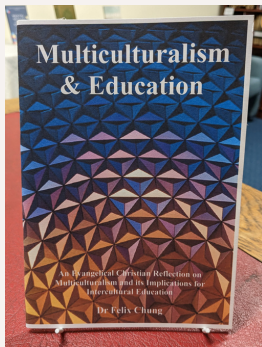


STRENGTH FOR TODAY

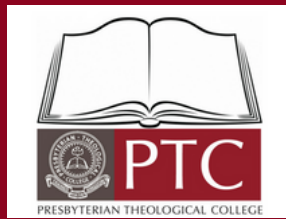


READ IN THE LIGHT
